GemStone/S 64 Bit 2.4.4.6 Release Notes

Overview

GemStone/S 64 Bit 2.4.4.6 is a new version of the GemStone/S 64 Bit object server. This release includes one change to permit shared page cache sizes that are larger than 75% of installed RAM.

No separate Installation Guide is provided with this release. For installation instructions, use the Installation Guide for version 2.4.

Changes in this Release

Removed limitation on SPC size of 75% of RAM

Previously, attempting to start a Stone with a configuration for SHR_PAGE_CACHE_SIZE_KB that was larger than 75% of physical RAM resulted in the system automatically reducing the cache size to the 75% value. (#41618).

This limit has been removed. (#41618).
